Area Agency on Aging

Betty LeRoy informs us about the Area Agency on Aging's services to the elderly in this area. Their services are free. They provide meals in Barton. They provide assistance to folks attempting to sign up for federal programs such as Medicare Part D. They help people connect with local services such as Home Health. Neighbors helping neighbors. There is no consideration of a person's income – everyone is eligible.

Four-Wheelers on Town Roads

Phil and Sue met with us in hopes of improving the situation with four-wheelers on town roads. They would like to see our roads open to four-wheelers. They will do some homework on this, looking at other towns and at our earlier draft ordinance, and then get back to us.

Roads

There were some "not major" washouts recently but that is now put to rights. A little beaver activity behind the town garage and at Jim Rodger's pond has been taken care of. The new fill in front of the ambulance bay settled and washed during the downpour and required repair. We agree to buy a couple loads of clean sign to improve the town beach. It's time to have Taplins begin servicing the toilets at the beach. The new truck we have ordered may be delivered later than we would like, in which case we may need to hire a ten-wheeler to do some of our long distance hauling of gravel for road rebuilding this summer.

Cemetery Commissioner

Carlton Bickford has submitted his resignation as cemetery commissioner. We accept with regret his resignation and express our gratitude for his years of public service to the town. We agree to appoint Ricky Blanchard to replace Carlton.

Glover Sewer System

We discuss various aspects of the West Glover sewer project, including pending easements and design/location of the proposed booster pump.

Hazardous Waste Cleanup

The most recently removed contaminated soil from the Ambulance Bay has now been removed from our gravel pit.

Recreation Fields

The new fields are proving to be very popular and busy. Keone and his family have built some benches and plan to build more. We need to arrange for a porta-potty, and perhaps some more parking space.

Miscellaneous

Other routine clerical and administrative matters were attended to.
